I understand that navigating the FEMA application process can feel overwhelming, but I'm here to help you through it. Here's a compassionate, step-by-step guide to assist you in completing the application successfully. You're not alone in this, and every step you take is important.

- ☒ Go to DisasterAssistance.gov
- ☒ Click on Sign In and create an online account (you will need access to email)
- ☒ Return to home page
- ☒ Click on the red APPLY NOW button
- ☒ Enter your Zip Code (40601 for Frankfort)
- ☒ Select the disaster that affected you (Until the April disaster is added, select February 14th)
- ☒ Select your area (Until Franklin County is listed, hit next)
- ☒ Select Next on screen
- ☒ Check all the assistance that you need and click Next
- ☒ Verify this is your primary home (six months or more a year) -
If the property is not your primary residence you can go to SBA.gov
- ☒ Verify additional needs
- ☒ Enter the date of disaster (4/5/2025)
- ☒ Type of damage (flood)

- ☒ Once you get logged in, start the application
- ☒ Double-check all the information you entered, and where you are sure it's correct, submit the application.

REMEMBER: This application is a legal document. Be sure to complete it fully and honestly.
