\overline{V}	Go to DisasterAssistance.gov
\checkmark	Click on Sign In and create an online account (you will need access to email)
	Return to home page
\checkmark	Click on the red APPLY NOW button
	Enter your Zip Code (40601 for Frankfort)
	Select the disaster that affected you (Until the April disaster is added, select February 14th)
	Select your area (Until Franklin County is listed, hit next)
	Select Next on screen
	Check all the assistance that you need and click Next
\checkmark	Verify this is your primary home (six months or more a year) - If the property is not your primary residence you can go to SBA.gov
\checkmark	Verify additional needs
	Enter the date of disaster (4/5/2025)
\checkmark	Type of damage (flood)
\checkmark	Once you get logged in, start the application
☑ app	Double-check all the information you entered, and where you are sure it's correct, submit the lication.

REMEMBER: This application is a legal document. Be sure to complete it fully and honestly.
